

## UNDERGRADUATE FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM FAQ

Question	Answer
<b>General application and selection queries</b>	
Who can apply for a Fellowship position?	Mulgrave Private Hospital welcomes applications from both domestic and international students to take up Fellowship Program positions
How many Fellowship positions will be offered?	There is no defined number of Fellowship positions available, though commonly we appoint between 6-8 students for each intake We are more seeking to appoint those suitable applicants who will reflect the Mulgrave Private Hospital organisational values and aspire to provide excellent standards of patient centred care
How is the selection process conducted?	Some Education Providers use video submission via their own portal, while students from other Universities/TAFEs are required to apply directly to Mulgrave Undergraduate team. Application submission dates will be provided to students by their training schools.
<b>The undergraduate Fellowship Program</b>	
Do I have the ability to select my clinical allocations?	YES Prior to each clinical placement you will be given the opportunity to select your preferred area. This must correlate with the Deakin University curriculum, i.e. if a general ward placement is required you cannot request to go to a specialty area such as ICU
Can I request a specialty rotation?	YES When the booked placement is scheduled to be in a specialty location you will be given the opportunity to select your preferred area from ICU, CCU, ED or the Theatre department
What are the Electives offered during clinical placements?	While you are on placement you will have the opportunity to select an area of interest or activity that is relevant to the area of placement E.g. a visit to the Cath Lab when on the Cardiology ward or time spent with our Stoma Nurse when on the GI ward
What clinical support is provided during placements?	During placements you will be supported by a dedicated team of Undergraduate educators as well as by the buddy nurses and preceptors you are allocated to work with As part of your rotation you are also encouraged to attend Undergraduate debriefs to meet with the rest of the student cohort and spend time with the educators
Is on-site education available for Fellowship Program students?	YES During your placement you are invited to attend education sessions being delivered to the organisation's nursing team. This may include inservices, tutorials or workshops covering a broad range of topics
<b>Ongoing employment opportunities</b>	
What are my employment opportunities at the end of the Fellowship Program?	All undergraduate students who successfully complete the Fellowship Program are offered a guaranteed interview for our Graduate Nurse Program

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
